1. The tournament opener of ICC World Cup 2019 was held between England and South Africa at Kennington Oval, London.

6. Jammu and Kashmir Government on May 29, 2019, unveiled Healthcare Investment Policy-2019. This follows the State Administrative Council decision taken in this regard on March 08, 2019.

9. Kerala will levy a 1% cess on most goods and services in the state from 1 June to raise funds to rebuild the state from the devastation wreaked by last year's floods.
10. Opposition Congress Party today formally announced its spokespersons would go off air for a month, a move comes amid post-poll chaos in the Grand Old Party alongside Rahul Gandhi's insistence on quitting.
