1. Assistant Professor of Agricultural Microbiology :

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Agricultural Microbiology** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

2. Assistant Professor of Agricultural Extension Education :

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Agricultural Extension Education** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

3. Assistant Professor of Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry :

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

4. Assistant Professor of Animal Science:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in any branch of **Animal Science** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

5. Assistant Professor of Statistics:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Statistics or Agricultural Statistics** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. The Candidates are exempted from getting Ph.D. with course work.
- iv. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- v. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

6. Assistant Professor of Home Science (Food & Nutrition) :

- i. A four years Bachelor's Degree from recognised farm university is essential.
- ii. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Home Science (Food & Nutrition) or MSc in Food Technology** from a recognized University.
- iii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iv. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- v. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

7. Assistant Professor of Sericulture:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Sericulture** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

8. Assistant Professor of Farm Machinery and Power Engineering:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Farm Machinery & Power Engineering** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

9. Assistant Professor of Agro Forestry:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Agro Forestry** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
