1. Assistant Professor of Agronomy

- i. Good Academic record with at least 55% of the marks at the **M.Sc. (Agri.) in Agronomy** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iv. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- v. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

2. Assistant Professor of Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry :

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Soil Science & Agricultural Chemistry** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

3. Assistant Professor of Horticulture:

- i. Good Academic record with at least 55% of the marks at the **M.Sc. (Agri.) in Horticulture or M.Sc. (Horticulture) in any branch of Horticulture** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

4. Assistant Professor of Plant Pathology

- i. Good Academic record with at least 55% of the marks at the **M.Sc. (Agri.) in Plant Pathology** from a recognized University.
- ii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length

- papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
 - iv. NET/SLET/SET shall not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

5. Assistant Professor of Home Science (Food & Nutrition) :

- i. A four years Bachelor's Degree in Food Nutrition from recognised university is essential.
- ii. Good academic record with at least 55% marks or its equivalent at the Master's Degree level in **Home Science (Food & Nutrition)** from a recognized University.
- iii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.

Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
- iii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR, ICAR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

- iii. NET is compulsory along with one publication in NAAS (National Academy of Agricultural Sciences, New Delhi) rated refereed journal for recruitment to the post of Assistant Professor and equivalent in the disciplines in which NET is conducted. Essentiality of NET can be waived-off for the candidates holding Ph.D. degree provided it has been done with course work as prescribed by the UGC Regulations 2009, and the candidate has at least two full length papers in journals having a NAAS rating not less than 4 or a minimum of 4 full length papers in NAAS rated SAU journals, as on the last date of submission of application. Those candidates with Ph.D. degree without course work will not qualify for NET exemption.
