Notification

In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (3) and (7) of rule 11 of the Rules and Regulations of the Association of the Karnataka Residential Educational Institutions Society (KREIS), the Governing council of the Karnataka Residential Educational Institutions Society with the approval of the Government of Karnataka and MoU between National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), here by Make the following Rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the posts mentioned in the Annexure (I-XX) to this notification in the Ekalavya Model Residential Schools _EMRS. It is to state that the affected people submitting any objections or advises after 15 days of publication of below Draft Notification are not considered.

Before completion of prescribed period any person submitting any objections or advises are considered by Government. Any objections or advises are submitted to Secretary to Government, Karnataka Government Secretariat, Social Welfare Department, Vikasa Soudha, Bangalore-560001.

DRAFT NOTIFICATION

Preamble:

The Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA) was set up in 1999, with the objective of providing more focused approach on the integrated socio-economic development of the Scheduled Tribes (STs), the most underprivileged of the Indian Society, in a coordinated and planned manner. Since its inception, endeavor of Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been to take various initiatives for overall upliftment of Tribals across the country. Amongst these, providing quality education to ST students has been the main focus of the Ministry as educational development is a stepping-stone to economic and social upliftment and is also the most effective instrument for overall empowerment. In pursuance of the goal to impart quality education to ST

students, Ekalavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) have been established which are co-educational residential schools from Class VI to XII. Government of Karnataka has granted permission to KREIS to enter MoU with NESTS and to manage EMRS schools as per their guidelines under the supervision of Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India. Ministry of tribal affairs has sanctioned 12 Ekalavya model residential schools to Karnataka state and all are operational since from 1999.

NESTS, as an autonomous Society under the Ministry of Tribal Affairs has been registered under Societies Registration Act, 1860. The National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), an autonomous organization has been set up to establish and manage Ekalavya Model Residential Schools across the country. Karnataka Residential Education Institution Society- Kreis has signed MOU with NESTS on 15.10.2020 to maintain, control and manage the schools as per the guideline and norms formulated by the NESTS and the Ministry of Tribal affairs, Govt of India. NESTS has taken several initiatives in the recent past to improve the quality of education in the EMRSs. In order to ensure quality teaching in EMRSs, NESTS is conducting a special drive in association with the State Governments to fill up the vacancies of teaching and Non teaching staff . NESTS has formulated Ekalavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) Recruitment Rules 2021 for recruitment of 52 Teaching and non teaching Posts. NESTS has circulated Recruitments Rules to state EMRS societies D.O. letter 18015/1/2017 – Grants Dated 12.02.2020, subsequently finalized recruitment rules with amendments in the following documents.

Nests has requested KREIS to Notify the above RR rules vide letter F. No NESTS/Admin/EMRS Teaching staff Rect/104/2021-22 Dated: 28th June 2021 . Accordingly the draft Notification was prepared and sent to Department of parliamentary affairs and Legislation and Finance Department, Government of Karnataka for approval. Both the departments have concurred the Ekalavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) Recruitment Rules 2021. Hence, the following Notification.

In exercise of the powers conferred under clause (3) and (7) of rule 11 of the Rules and Regulations of the Association of the Karnataka Residential Educational Institutions Society(KREIS), the Governing council of the Karnataka Residential Educational Institutions Society with the approval of the Government of Karnataka and MoU between National Education Society for Tribal Students (NESTS), here by make the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the posts mentioned in the Annexure (I-XX) to this notification in the Ekalvya Model Residential Schools-EMRS.

1. Short Title and Commencement of rules:

- a. These rules may be called "Ekalvya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) Recruitment Rules 2021".
- b. They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette of Government of Karnataka.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scales of Pay.

- a. The number of posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to this notification. Senior scale, selection grade and the Assured Career Promotion (ACP) shall be made applicable to the eligible posts in accordance with the orders issued by the National Educational Society for Tribal Students (NESTS) from time to time and as adopted by the Society.
- b. Wherever, regular service in a specific scale of pay is mentioned as part of qualification/experience for the post, the allowances attached to that scale shall be comparable or equivalent to that prescribed by the NESTS.
- 3. Method of Recruitment, Age-limit and other Qualifications.
 - a. The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 6 to 13 of the said Schedule.
 - b. The upper age-limit as prescribed in column 6 will be relaxable up to 5 years in the case of employees of National Education Society for Tribal Students wherever the post is filled up by Direct Recruitment.
 - c. The Upper age-limit prescribed by direct recruitment shall be relaxable in the case of candidates belonging to the Schedule Castes & Schedule Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued in this behalf from time to time by the Government of Karnataka.
 - d. For promotion to the various posts under the EMRSs, the composition of the Departmental Promotion Committees for different categories of posts is given in column 12 of the said Schedule.
 - e. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, the Executive Director of the Society may, in case of urgent need, permit appointment on short- term contract against any post included in these Rules on a consolidated remuneration, provided that the amount of remuneration shall not exceed the pay plus dearness allowance admissible at the minimum of the pay of the post. In such cases the contract period shall not normally exceed one year unless otherwise specified.

4. Probation

- a. Every direct recruit shall initially be appointed on probation. The period of probation shall be two years from the date of appointment, which may be extended by another two years by the competent authority for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- b. When an employee appointed to a post on probation has completed his/her probation to the satisfaction of the appointing authority, he/she shall be eligible for confirmation of appointment or continuance therein as the case may be, and such confirmation of appointment shall be made in the order of seniority as indicated in the relevant select panel.
- c. An employee appointed as a direct recruit to any post in the National Education Society for Tribal Students, specified in the Schedule, who has no lien on any post under the Central Government or any State Govt. or the Karnataka Residential Educational Society-KREIS shall, while on probation, be liable to be discharged from the post at any time with one month's notice or pay in lieu thereof. if
 - i. On the basis of his/her performance or conduct during the probation he/she is considered unfit for further retention in the postconcerned, or
 - ii. On the basis of any information relating to his/her nationality, testimonials, age, health or antecedents, the appointing authority is satisfied that he/she is ineligible or otherwise unfit for being an employee of the National Education Society for Tribal Students.
- d. A direct recruit who holds a lien on a post under the Central Government or any State Government or in the Society may, while on probation, be reverted to such post at any time on grounds of any of the circumstances specified in sub - rule (i) and (ii) above.

5. Disqualification

No person-

- a. Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- b. Having a spouse living has entered in to or contracted marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Society may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the Personnel Law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

6. Residuary Matters

In regard to matters not specified/referred to in these Rules, the employees holding the posts specified in the Schedule shall be governed by the regulations and orders applicable to the employees of the Society in general.

7. Power to Relax

When the Executive Committee of the Society upon a recommendation made by the Commissioner, NESTS Society to the effect, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of posts or persons. All administrative orders/instructions provided for any relaxation, exemption etc. of the provisions of Recruitment Rules issued prior to notification of these Revised Rules shall stand superseded after notification of these Rules.
