KHPT is looking for short-term consultants to support developing the livelihood modules for the Sphoorthi programs, which are implemented in northern Karnataka districts.

Consultant – Livelihood (Part-time)

Position: 1 Project: APPI Sphoorthi Location: Bangalore Reporting to: Project Lead, APPI Sphoorthi Consultancy Period: November 2022-May 2022 (10 days/month)

The livelihood training module is to be developed as part of KHPT's Sphoorthi adolescent girls' empowerment programme, being conducted in Koppal district, Karnataka. It was conceived from the need to engage the resource girls (or Sphoorthi girls, trained during the first round of the Sphoorthi project between 2015-2018) meaningfully, in relation to their current needs. With most girls of trained in the first round between the ages of 17-19 years, and with many of them having completed schooling, livelihood opportunities are critical to engage the girls through new activities, and sustain the advantages in terms of self-esteem, confidence, improved parent daughter relationships and agency, gained from the implementation of the first round of the Sphoorthi intervention. The livelihood component will not focus on training girls on any specific livelihood skills (e.g., tailoring). Rather, the aim is to encourage girls to develop an orientation towards livelihood, understand the ways in which the economy and labour market function, critically question the possibilities of realizing their own aspirations (e.g., in terms of what support or [gender] barriers) may exist, and gain the skills to negotiate this.

Scope of Work:

- 1. Work closely with designated KHPT team member to consolidate learnings / findings on Livelihoods for adolescents
- 2. Identify and map local / state level NGOs/CBOs working on livelihoods
- 3. Arrange a consultation with local/state level NGOs/CBOs to draw inputs to design a livelihood module
- 4. Develop a livelihood module
- 5. Arrange for a consultation to review the livelihood module
- 6. Disseminate livelihood model / train key district staff on how to use the module to train Sphoorthi resource girls
